4 **PLAY**

Pretend to be an Olympic athlete. Try long jumping, somersaults, and sprinting!

5 **TALK**

Talk about the weather today. What is it like outside today?

6 **SING**

Sing or listen to a song while you walk, like "We Are The Dinosaurs" by Laurie Berkner.

7 **READ**

Read a book about fall like *Mouse's First Fall* by Lauren Thompson.

8 **WRITE**

Pick up some leaves from outside. Put them under a piece of paper and rub a crayon over the top.

9 **MATH**

Sort your stuffed animals into piles by color.

10 **PLAY**

Pretend to be a bear getting ready to hibernate. Make yourself a cave to hibernate in.

11 **TALK**

Talk about what you do to get ready for the day.

12 **SING**

Sing a song as if you were a dog.

13 **READ**

Read a book with a person as the main character.

14 **WRITE**

Make a list of the books you've read this week and draw a star by your favorites.

15 **MATH**

Draw a map of your bedroom - don't forget to show where the windows and doors are!

16 **PLAY**

Pretend a cardboard box is your racecar! Zoom around the track!

17 **TALK**

Ask a grown-up about something special that happened to them today.

18 **SING**

Ask a grown-up to sing you one of their favorite songs from when they were a kid.

19 **READ**

Read a nonfiction book about an animal.

20 **WRITE**

Practice drawing lines today by doing some maze puzzles.

21 **MATH**

Gather some leaves or sticks outside and line them up smallest to biggest.

22 **PLAY**

Pretend you are going to the zoo. Walk around like some of the animals you would see.

23 **TALK**

What words can you think of that start with the R sound?

24 **SING**

Play the song game with a grown-up. Ask them to sing the first line of a nursery rhyme and you sing the rest!

25 **READ**

Read a spooky book like *Scary, Scary Halloween* by Eve Bunting.

26 **WRITE**

Make apple prints. Have a grown-up cut an apple in half. Dip it in paint and press it to paper.

27 **MATH**

Count the number of orange things you can find in your house.

28 **PLAY**

Roll toy cars through a paper towel tube. Pretend it's a tunnel!

29 **TALK**

If you are dressing up for Halloween, talk about your costume.

30 **SING**

Listen to a quiet song before you go to bed.

31 **READ**

Watch a Virtual Storytime with Miss Andrea!
