Sunday

Monday

1 TALK

How many words can you think of that rhyme with bear?

Tuesday

2 SING

Make a song cube. Draw a picture for each song. Roll the cube and sing the song that's on top!

Wednesday

3 READ

Read a book that you can sing along to, like *Baby Beluga*.

Thursday

4 WRITE

Draw a picture and write your name under it.

Friday

5 MATH

Find and count green things in your house.

Saturday

6 PLAY

Make wings out of construction paper. Ask your grown-up to tape them to your sweatshirt and fly around!

7 TALK

Talk about words that start with a "B" sound like baby or banana.

8 SING

Sing your favorite nursery rhyme in a silly voice.

9 READ

Read a book that has a child as the main character, like *Daniel's Good Day*.

10 WRITE

Color or scribble on a heart shape with a red crayon.

11 MATH

Pick a number of the day. Call it out whenever you see it!

12 PLAY

Put different feeling things in a bag. Stick your hand in and feel them all. Don't peek!

13 TALK

Talk about something fun you can do together today.

14 SING

Make up a song about love and friendship.

15 READ

Read a book with a red cover.

16 WRITE

Use a blue crayon to keep track of all the blue things you see today.

17 MATH

Make water beads. Look at them before you add water and after. Which are bigger?

18 PLAY

Have a tea party with your grown-up or stuffed animals. Be very fancy.

19 TALK

After you read a story, talk about words that are new to you in the book.

20 SING

Ask your grown-up to sing you a bedtime story instead of reading one!

21 READ

Ask a grown-up to read you a story while you're in the tub!

22 WRITE

Use two fingers to pop the bubbles on some bubble wrap.

23 MATH

Draw different shapes on a piece of paper. Color them in.

24 PLAY

Put unscented shaving cream in a tub and use spoons to scoop it up

25 TALK

Talk about the opposites "on" and "off" today.

26 SING

Change a song you like to have your name in it!

27 READ

Read a book that has rhyming text.

28 WRITE

Draw a squiggly line and then put stickers all along the line.
